Whereas, Unnecessary idling of vehicles pollutes the air, increases the costs of goods and services, increases U.S. dependence on foreign oil, and contributes to the climate crisis; and

Whereas, a citizens' group and the City of Tallahassee have implemented a campaign to educate citizens and visitors in Leon County about this issue and urge them to cease unnecessary idling; now, therefore be it

Resolved, That the **Apalachee Audubon Society (AAS)** become a partner in the **Idle Free Tallahassee– Leon** campaign;

Resolved, That the Board of Directors of **AAS** take steps to educate our members about the need to eliminate unnecessary idling of their own vehicles; and


Resolved, That the Board encourage our members to take the Idle-Free Pledge on the City of Tallahassee website www.talgov.com.
